- The Jowonio School Board of Directors established a Scholarship Fund to assist parents with hardships to help pay a portion of their tuition amount for their income level. The application deadline is July for the following school year. The Scholarship Committee make a determination based on the scholarship funds available and notifies parents in August.
- Since many families prefer to budget and pay on a weekly basis, we have our tuition based on 38 payments weeks for the school year and 6 payment weeks for the summer session. This includes scheduled school holidays, when your child is absent for illness or vacation, or if school is unexpectedly closed for inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

### Board of Directors Policy Statement of Tuition

Parents who contract with Jowonio to pay tuition are urged to keep their payments up to date. Your weekly tuition payment is due on the first day of the week that school is in session during the school year. In cases where payments are delinquent, the following policy has been adopted.

<u>Weeks Past Due</u>	<u>Action</u>
2 Weeks	Written Reminder
3 Weeks	Verbal Follow Up
4 Weeks	Letter from Director
5 Weeks	Refer to Collection and parent(s) notified to remove child from school within 10 days

We typically operate on a very tight budget and timely receipt of parent tuition is required for us to meet our expenses. If your payment must be delayed for any reason, we ask that you notify us immediately. We will try to develop a plan for the payment of your tuition.
